Background:

The current 21-year-old under-the-counter sanitizer has a long history of maintenance issues and continual sudsing regardless of how many technicians come to visit it or how many hours members spend trying to get the suds gone.

A cursory internet search for suitable replacements shows a range of \$3,000 to \$5,000 for this appliance.
