

SOP – Nameplate Policy

Nameplates installed on walers are limited to one per boat owner and shall be 2" by 10" in order to be slipped into an aluminum nameplate holder (to be provided and installed by the Club). The nameplate shall have the Member's name(s), and, if provided by the Club, will be in the in the order requested by the Member. Existing "home-made" nameplates attached to walers are grandfathered in (as of April 2021), but replacement of such should adhere to the above specifications.

Many Members like to include more than just their names on the nameplates. This may include their kids name(s) and/or their boat name etc. There is not a problem with this as long as only standard size nameplates meeting the above specifications are placed in the nameplate holder which is attached to the walers (or as grandfathered in, attached to the waler directly). If the additional information does not fit the 2" by 10" nameplate holder the Member shall apply the additional nameplate to the Member's dock box.

Members may obtain their own compliant nameplates or request that they be made by Ron Moran for a small fee.
