

Making Work Hour Totals Available to Members

Proposal:

I move that Work Hours, totaled to date, be available on the members-only portion of the club's website for membership access.

1. Information published will include:
 - a. Membership name
 - b. Total hours worked in each semi-annual half of year and year-to-date
 - c. Show separate columns for on-site and off-site hours
 - d. The date that the data was generated
2. The data would be generated at least twice per month and more often leading up to June 10 and December 10 deadlines.
3. Presentation of data. Options for discussion:
 - a. Work Hours can be viewed just for your own membership, and including totals for the entire club, through some query submitted on our website. (The format could be similar to the top couple of rows of the attached example, but excluding data for all the other members.)

OR:

- b. Work Hours for all memberships shown in 1 report (example attached) and one looks up their name in an alphabetical list.

Two potential ways of managing any privacy concerns:

- i. A membership can Opt-Out from being included in the list if they want to keep their hours private.
- ii. OR, memberships Opt-In if they want to be included on the full report.

Either way, for any members not shown in a full list, they could submit an inquiry for their own Work Hours information.

Note, in any case, members in Life Active status will show highlighted in light blue with a note indicating that they are not required to perform work hours.

Reasoning:

1. Members are regularly asking for this data.
2. This does not divulge any confidential information (it would be an auto-generated report from the official tracking files, excluding notes, exceptions, etc.)
3. There will be no surprises when semi-annual deadlines approach.
