Moorage Report
November, 2023

The moorage remains fully assigned with Slip 4 on Walk 2a becoming usable again due to a boat move described below. There are 4 members on the list waiting for initial moorage and one member in a sublet slip. I have no indication of any possible vacancies in the near future. The current Moorage Assignment workbook is available upon request.

Moorage activity since the October Board Meeting:

Jay Russo, with his Pearson 28, has been reassigned to Slip 3 from Slip 15 on Walk 3.

Eric and Leslie Foren, with their Carver 28, named *Pickle*, have been reassigned to Slip 15 on Walk 3 from Slip 3 on Walk 2a. This move opens up an additional space to moor a boat in Slip 4 on Walk 2a.

Bruce Newton, with his Merit 25 has been reassigned to Slip 4 from Slip 2 on Walk 2a.

Christian Steinbrecher, with his Cape Dory 25, has been reassigned to Slip 3 on Walk 2a from Slip 29 on Walk 3.

Teresa Long, with her sailboat, a Seward 25, named, *Miss Molly*, has been assigned temporary moorage in Slip 34 on Walk 3 commencing a sublet of the slip assigned to Rock and Dena Kent. Teresa has subsequently been assigned to Christian's vacated slip, Slip 29 on Walk 3 that will end her sublet from the Kents.

Linda Starr, with her Erickson 23, was moved from Slip 17 to Slip 12 on Walk 3 switching sublets from Jas Adams to David Paul. Then she was moved to a slip of her own, Slip 2 on Walk 2a, ending her sublet from David Paul.

Jeremy and Shannon Chedester, with their Beneteau 30, Bon Vent, have been assigned to Slip 21 on Walk 4

Ron Moran has sold his sailboat, named *Honahlee*, to club member Dean Terry and Dean will be taking over sublet obligations from Ron. *Honahlee* is presently moored in Slip 27 on Walk 1 and will stay there for now. This is a sublet from slip assignee Mark Miller.

Tom and Cathy Skach have removed their second boat, *Magic*, from Slip 2 on Walk 1 ending their sublet from Alison Mazon.

The dredge work in the southeast corner of the moorage is complete and the 4 boats that were moved out of the way have returned to their regular slips. Thanks goes to the Dredge Crews who moved John Kneeland's boat.
