Propose to complete purchase and install new VHF radio, antenna and depth sounder on launch. Approximate cost to be \$500

Background: This request has been discussed and approved by previous Board but was not yet completed. As there would be an expenditure of money associated with this action, it was felt appropriate to seek reapproval by current Board before proceeding.

Although handheld radios cover short line of site distances longer distance communication become impossible with lower power units. Examples would be supporting the RCYC medium distance race and Cruising events.
